

The Bone Church is an ossuary (kostnice) properly called the Chapel of all Saints, in the Kutna Hora suburb of Sedlec, 1 km from the main train station (Kutna Hora hl.n.). It's open 7 days a week, (except 24 Dec.) from 9am until at least 4pm. In the low season closed Noon-1pm.

(1) St Barbara's cathedral is possibly the Czech Republic's most impressive church. It's open every day except 24 Dec at least from 10am-4pm.

(2) Hrádek is the building housing the Museum of Silver Mining. Guided tours into the mines as far as 6 floors below ground. Hardhats and torches are supplied. Open Apr-Oct 9am-5pm (closed Mondays)

(3) The Italian Court/Vlašský Dvůr is the old royal mint. All year 9am to at least 4pm

(4) The Alchemy museum is in the same building as the tourist information office. Open year round at least from 10am to 4pm
